WARRANTY

FULL

LIMITED WARRANTY. The dealer will pay ____% of the labor and ____% of the parts for the covered systems that fail during the warranty period. Ask the dealer for a copy of the warranty document for a full explanation of warranty coverage, exclusions, and the dealer's repair obligations. Under state law, "implied warranties" may give you even more rights.

SYSTEM & COVERED PARTS:

1. ENGINE: All internally lubricated parts, fuel pump and water pump, block, heads and manifolds, harmonic balancer, fuel injectors, carburetor, turbo charger, and engine mounts.

2. TRANSMISSION: All internally lubricated parts, converter and modular valve, gear cases/housing, metal cooler lines and cooler, transfer case and its internal parts.

3. DRIVE AXLE: All internally lubricated parts, shafts and bearings, CV/Ujoints, propeller shaft, gear case/housing, flex disc, center bearings, and yokes.

4. BRAKES: Master/wheel cylinders, assist booster, calipers and propotioning valve.

5. STEERING: Internally lubricated parts of the steering gear and power steering pump, housings, steering column shaft and coupling.

6. ELECTRICAL: Alternator, regulator, ignition module and coil, stater, distributor, electronic control module, electric windows and seat motors.

7. SUSPENSION: Control arms and shafts, ball joints, king pins, spindles and knuckles, wheel bearings, and MacPherson struts.

8. ENGINE COOLING: Radiator, engine cooling fan and fan motor.

NOTE: Fluids, seals, gaskets covered only when required with the replacement of a covered component(s)/part(s).

Dealership warranties this vehicle to be mechanically operational and sound:

- 30 days or 1,500 miles** - vehicle with purchase price from \$3,000.00 to \$4,999.99.
- 60 days or 3,000 miles** - vehicle with purchase price from \$5,000.00 or more.
- As Is - No Warranty** - vehicle with purchase prices up to \$2,999.99 or any vehicle that is 7 years or older which age should be calculated from the first day in January of the vehicle model year.

DURATION. The systems or parts covered above are guarenteed by a FULL LIMITED WARRANTY for 30 days or 1500 miles, whichever occurs first. ALL REPAIRS MUST BE DONE IN DEALER'S SHOP. NO OUTSIDE INVOICE WILL BE HONORED BY THE DEALER.

SERVICE CONTRACT. A service contract is available at an extra charge on this vehicle. Ask for details as to coverage, deductible, price, and exclusions. If you buy a service contract within 90 days of the time of sale, state law "implied warranties" may give you additional rights.

PRE-PURCHASE INSPECTION: ASK THE DEALER IF YOU MAY HAVE THIS VEHICLE INSPECTED BY YOUR MECHANIC EITHER ON OR OFF THE LOT.

Below is a list of some major defects that may occur in used motor vehicles.

Frame & Body

- Frame - cracks, corrective welds, or rusted through
- Dog tracks - bent or twisted frame

Engine

- Oil leakage, excluding normal seepage
- Cracked block or head
- Belts missing or inoperable
- Knocks or misses related to camshaft lifters and push rods
- Abnormal exhaust discharge

Transmission & Drive Shaft

- Improper fluid level or leakage, excluding normal seepage
- Cracked or damaged case which is visible
- Abnormal noise or vibration caused by faulty transmission or drive shaft
- Improper shifting or functioning in any gear
- Manual clutch slips or chatters

Differential

- Improper fluid level or leakage, excluding normal seepage
- Cracked or damaged housing which is visible
- Abnormal noise or vibration caused by faulty differential

Cooling System

- Leakage including radiator
- Improperly functioning water pump

Electrical System

- Battery leakage
- Improperly functioning alternator, generator, battery, or starter

Fuel System

- Visible leakage

Inoperable Accessories

- Gauges or warning devices
- Air Conditioner
- Heater & defroster

Brake System

- Failure warning light broken
- Pedal not firm under pressure (DOT spec.)
- Not enough pedal reserve (DOT spec.)
- Hoses damaged
- Drum or rotor too thin (Mfg. spec.)
- Lining or pad thickness less than 1/32 inch
- Power unit not operating or leaking
- Structural or mechanical parts damaged

Steering System

- Too much free play at steering wheel (DOT spec.)
- Free play in linkage more than 1/4 inch
- Steering gear binds or jams
- Front wheels aligned improperly (DOT spec.)
- Power unit belts cracked or slipping
- Power unit fluid level improper

Suspension System

- Ball joint seals damaged
- Structural parts bent or damaged
- Stabilizer bar disconnected
- Spring broken
- Shock absorber mounting loose
- Rubber bushings damaged or missing
- Radius rod damaged or missing
- Shock absorber leaking or functioning improperly

Tires

- Tread depth less than 2/32 inch
- Sizes mismatched
- Visual damage

Wheels

- Visible cracks, damage or repairs
- Mounting bolts loose or missing

Exhaust System

- Leakage
